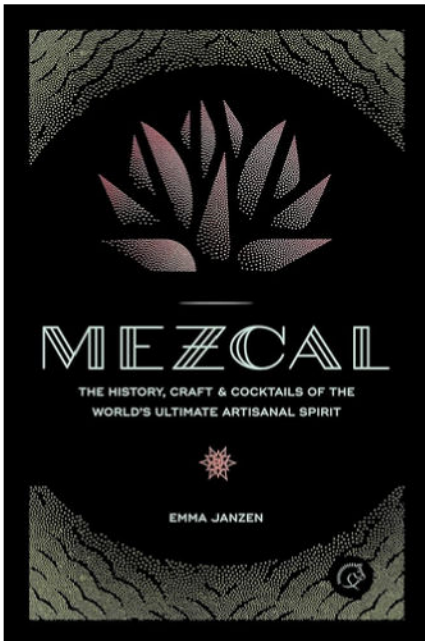

### **Mezcal: The History, Craft & Cocktails of the World's Ultimate Artisanal Spirit**

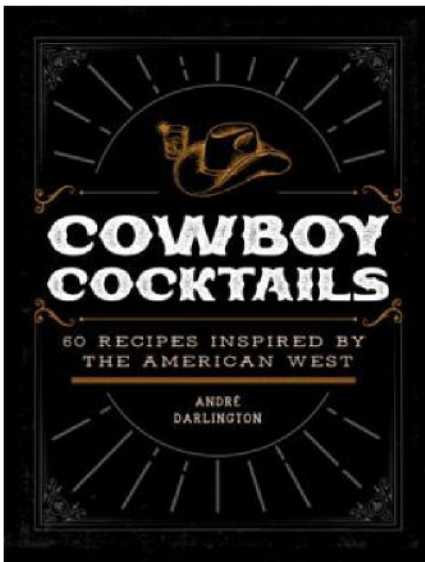
